

Over fifty years ago two women saw the potential of the old Wagner's Store in the main street of Jindera to become a museum

Like their forebears, who came to an unknown land, they saw an opportunity that could be developed to enhance the township of Jindera and would preserve their vital history for future generations. These two women encouraged 17 families to join together to purchase the land and buildings which became the Jindera Pioneer Museum.

Making history

For the museum to remain viable, we need to develop new exhibits and spaces that can attract an ever-changing audience. Funding for this type of development is limited and so we are looking for contributions to help us in this new phase of museum growth.

A new building that will house the Cottage Crafts, a museum shop, our new period costume photography studio and a 'hands-on' space where students can actually use some of the items that we have on display in the museum, is our next project. Plus an undercover area in the entrance space where students can leave their bags while visiting the museum.

To date the museum has won several awards for its excellence and the collection it houses is considered highly significant; derived mostly from families and properties in this area. The new exhibits and facilities will build on the great work this community has already achieved.
